



Mechanical Rubber Products, a custom contract manufacturer of rubber, plastic and metal, is compliant with MIL-I-45208 quality management system requirements.

The MIL-I-45208 specification provides standards for the inspection systems of those who contract for the U.S. Army, Navy, Air Force and Defense Supply departments. It is approved by the U.S. Department of Defense.

The standards require that inspection systems assure that supplies conform to contract requirements, that records of inspections and tests are maintained, and that contracts be subject to evaluation and audit by government representatives.

MIL-I-45208, however, is inactive for new design after Nov. 1995 and replaced by ISO 9001.
